Hints & Tips For the September 2015 Truck Solicitation



✓ Register with ARB and Obtain a TRUCRS ID Number

✓ Make Sure Your Truck is Eligible

- 75% operation within California for the past 2 years
- Move goods as part of a sales transaction
- Commit to at least 50% travel within the four California trade corridors
- Drayage trucks are now eligible
- Maintain compliance with the Statewide Truck and Bus Rule or Drayage Truck Rule
- Engine model year is 2009 or older for Class 7 and 8 trucks
- Engine model year is 1998 to 2009 for Class 6 trucks
- No Prop. 1B grants are available to fund PM filter retrofits

✓ Clear Outstanding ARB Vehicle and Fleet Violations

✓ Keep Truck Registered and in Legal Operating Condition

- Must continue to operate truck and move goods until new truck arrives
- Planned Non-Operation registration is NOT allowed

✓ Gather DMV Registration History or Request DMV Form (INF 1125)

✓ Gather and Organize Mileage Documentation

Local agency will request at least 2 records showing odometer readings

✓ Determine Manufacturer's Gross Vehicle Weight Rating

- Class 8 defined as greater than 33,000 GVWR
- Class 7 defined as 26,001 33,000 GVWR
- Class 6 defined as 19,501 26,000 GVWR
- Typically found on door tag
