The Air Resources Board (ARB) is requesting your participation in a survey of the natural gas transmission and distribution sector (NG T&D), excluding underground storage. Gathering this information is part of our responsibilities under AB 32, the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006 (Health and Safety Code section 38500 to 38599). The objective of this survey is to improve ARB's estimate of greenhouse gas emissions from this sector. The enclosed survey is mandatory and the requested information is due to ARB by **June 15, 2009**.

This request is made pursuant to sections 39607, 39701, and 41511 of the California Health and Safety Code, and Title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 91100. These sections authorize the ARB to require the submission of information needed to estimate atmospheric emissions and to carry out its other statutory responsibilities. All survey data will be protected as confidential information, in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, section 91000 to 91022 and the California Public Records Act (Government Code section 6250 et seq.).
