EXECUTIVE ORDER A-13

Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

Caterpillar

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Section 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Caterpillar Tractor Company diesel engines in 1973-model heavy-duty motor vehicles are approved for the engine families described below:

1673C	638	1673C
1674	638	1674
1693T	893	1693T
1693TA	893	1693TA

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the manufacturer's decal:
