EXECUTIVE ORDER A-4-13  
Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER COMPANY

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That International Harvester Company 1974 model year diesel-powered engines in heavy-duty motor vehicles are approved for the engine families described below:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size CID</u>	<u>Engine Model</u>	<u>Type</u>
V-800	798.1	V-800:350BHP, 325BHP, 300BHP, 280BHP Models	V-8 Turbocharged
DT-466	466.3	DT-466:235BHP, 230BHP, 225BHP, 215BHP, 200BHP, 180BHP Models	In-Line 6 Turbocharged

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbon plus Nitrogen Dioxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>
V-800	12	5
DT-466	15	3

These values are in effect until the termination of the 1974 engine model year of production.
