EXECUTIVE ORDER A-106-2-1
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

COACHMEN INDUSTRIES, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43835 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 1979 model year Coachmen Industries, Inc. motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds are certified using the gasoline engines listed below:

Executive Order A-106-2, dated April 30, 1979, is hereby rescinded.

Section 43200, Part 5, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the vehicle manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle. The decal shall display the applicable model year heavy-duty engine exhaust emission standards and the following certification emission values:


