EXECUTIVE ORDER A-6-199  
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43835 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That General Motors Corporation 1981 model year motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds are certified using the gasoline engines listed below:

Section 43200, Part 5, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the vehicle manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle. The decal shall display the applicable model year heavy-duty engine exhaust emission standards and the following certification emission values:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That 1981 model year vehicle models listed on the attached sheet also comply with "California Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 1978 and Subsequent Model Gasoline-Powered Motor Vehicles Except Motorcycles".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models also comply with the Board's "Specifications for Fill Pipes and Openings of Motor Vehicle Fuel Tanks" (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2290) for the aforementioned model year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That General Motors Corporation has provided to the Executive Officer all material required to demonstrate certification compliance with the Board's emission control system warranty regulations (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2036).

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this order.
