EXECUTIVE ORDER N-5  
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

FMC CORPORATION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100 and 43102 of the Health and Safety Code and Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 1956.7; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 1983 model-year FMC Corporation motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds are certified using the gasoline engines listed below:

Chrysler	BCC05.9AG6 (360-1)	360 (5.9)	170

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models also comply with the Board's "Specifications for Fill Pipes and Openings of Motor Vehicle Fuel Tanks" (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2290) for the aforementioned model-year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Executive Officer has been provided all material required to demonstrate certification compliance with the applicable federal emission control system warranty regulations pursuant to Section 207 of the Clean Air Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this certification is limited to nine vehicles.

The Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this order.
