EXECUTIVE ORDER A-57
Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

EXECUTIVE INDUSTRIES, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Executive Industries, Inc., 1973 model-year heavy-duty gasoline engine powered vehicles (Executive Motorhome) are approved as described below:

Chrysler	RBM	440 7.2	A-9-2

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that a decal be affixed to the side window which discloses the highest emissions from the certification fleet for that vehicle for which approval has been granted by the Board.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

<u>Engine Manufacturer</u>	<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbon Plus Nitrogen Dioxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>
Chrysler	RBM	14	12

These values are effective until the termination of 1973 model year production.
