

## **Attachment B: 15-Day Changes**

1. Provisions allowing end-users to install used systems on different vehicles– Staff may propose modifications to clarify the provisions allowing end-users to install used retrofit systems on different vehicles.

Among other things, this may include the addition of a new definition to section 2701 for the term “warranty period”. The intent would be to clarify that the warranty period refers to a period of time, distance, or usage that begins when a new diesel emission control system is installed for the first time on an end user’s vehicle. Subsequent installations on other vehicles or subsequent transfers of ownership would continue, but do not re-start, the existing warranty period.

Staff may also clarify that the warranty period for the installation warranty covers all installations that occur over that period, and is restarted with each new installation.

2. Aftertreatment installation requirements – Staff may propose modifications to section 2706(r), which requires that an aftertreatment device be designed such that it can only be installed with a specific orientation to ensure that the exhaust flow is always in the appropriate direction. Staff may, among other things, propose a later effective date and/or other provisions as appropriate to ensure that the requirements are feasible and conform to staff’s intent.
