EXECUTIVE ORDER R-10-011

Relating to the Public Hearing to Consider Proposed Amendments to the Area Designations for State Ambient Air Quality Standards

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2010, the Air Resources Board (Board or ARB) conducted a public hearing to consider amendments to the area designations for State ambient air quality standards, as set forth in the Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on February 4, 2010;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on March 25, 2010, the Board adopted Resolution 10-17, in which the Board directed the Executive Officer to determine if additional conforming modifications to the regulation are appropriate and if no additional modifications are appropriate, the Executive Officer shall take final action to adopt the regulation, as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has determined that no additional conforming modifications are appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 09-36 are incorporated by reference herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendments to California Code of Regulations, title 17, sections 60201, 60203, 60207, 60210, 70300, 70301, 70302, 70303, 70303.1, 70303.5, 70304, 70305, 70306, and Appendices 1 through 4, thereof, are adopted, as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.
