The Office of Administrative Law (OAL) is authorized to make the following corrections, substitutions, and additions in connection with the above-referenced rulemaking:

- (1) Substitute the enclosed revised final regulation text and the following list of documents incorporated by reference behind each copy of the Form 400 for filing with the Secretary of State and as the attachments to Executive Order R-12-005 in Tab 2 of the rulemaking file:
 - a. California Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 2005-2012 Small Off-Road Engines, Adopted July 26, 2004, as last amended October 25, 2012.

This document was inadvertently omitted from the file and should be included in this rulemaking. Please attach it to the Form 400 and to the Executive Order R-12-005 in Tab 2 of the rulemaking file.
- (3) Substitute the enclosed revised and updated Table of Contents before Tab 1 in the rulemaking file.
