

FINAL REGULATION ORDER

AMENDMENTS TO THE LIST OF VAPOR RECOVERY EQUIPMENT DEFECTS THAT SUBSTANTIALLY IMPAIR THE EFFECTIVENESS OF GASOLINE VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEMS

Amend California Code of Regulations, title 17, section 94006(b), solely to show the new amendment date of the document incorporated by reference, as follows:

§94006. Defects Substantially Impairing the Effectiveness of Vapor Recovery Systems Used in Motor Vehicle Fueling Operations.

(b) For the purposes of section 41960.2 of the Health and Safety Code, equipment defects in systems for the control of gasoline vapors resulting from motor vehicle fueling operations which substantially impair the effectiveness of the systems in reducing air contaminants are set forth in the “Vapor Recovery Equipment Defects List” amended on ~~June 17, 2008~~ June 11, 2012, which is incorporated by reference herein.
