## State of California AIR RESOURCES BOARD

## Executive Order G-99-030

WHEREAS, at its public hearing on September 24, 1998, the California Air Resources Board (the Board) approved the amendment of the criteria used for designating areas with respect to the State ambient air quality standards (State standards), as contained in title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR), sections 70300 through 70306 and Appendices 1 through 4, thereof; and the amendment of the area designations for State standards, as contained in title 17, CCR, sections 60201 through 60209;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing the Board adopted Resolution 98-47, in which the Board approved modifications of the amendments to the area designation regulations originally proposed in the Initial Statement of Reasons (Staff Report) released on August 7, 1998;

WHEREAS, Resolution 98-47 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, after making them available to the public for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, shall make modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations were available for public comment for one 15-day period, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of title 1, CCR, section 44; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has considered all written comments received during the 15-day period and has determined that these comments do not require the Board to reconsider or modify the approved regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 98-47 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the criteria for designating areas with respect to the State standards contained in title 17, CCR, sections 70300 through 70306 and Appendices 1 through 4, thereof, and the area designations contained in sections 60201 through 60209 are amended as set forth in Attachment 1 to this Executive Order.
