PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED ADOPTION OF AIRBORNE TOXIC CONTROL MEASURE AMENDMENTS LIMITING ONBOARD INCINERATION ON CRUISE SHIPS AND OCEANGOING SHIPS

Shown below are the staff's suggested conceptual modifications to the originally proposed amendments set forth in Appendix A to the Staff Report: Initial Statement of Reasons released September 29, 2006. Staff has not yet developed specific regulatory language to incorporate these conceptual modifications. All proposed modifications will be made available to the public for a fifteen-day comment period prior to final adoption.

- 1. Delete the recordkeeping requirement while operating in Regulated California Waters.
- Add recordkeeping requirement within 3 nautical miles of the California coast.
- Add provision for ARB to access and review incinerator records out to 24 nautical miles, which are required under federal and international law.
- 4. Delete the definition of "Estuarine Waters."
- 5. Delete the definition of "Regulated California Waters."
