## **EXECUTIVE ORDER G-97-006**

WHEREAS, on September 26, 1996, the Air Resources Board ("Board") conducted a public hearing to consider amendments to the Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program Fee Regulation for Fiscal Year 1996-97, set forth in sections 90700-90705, and Appendix A, Title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR);

WHEREAS, following the public hearing the Board adopted Resolution 96-45, in which the Board approved amendment of sections 90700-90705, and Appendix A, Title 17, CCR, as set forth in Attachments A and B thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 96-45 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, after making them available to the public for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, shall make modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations were available for public comment for two 15-day periods, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, CCR, section 44;

WHEREAS, all written comments received during the two 15-day periods have been considered by the Executive Officer and do not require modification nor reconsideration by the Board of the approved regulations;

WHEREAS, the reporting requirements of the approved regulations which apply to small business are necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 96-45 are incorporated herein.
