PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF A PROPOSED REGULATION TITLED "DEFINITION OF A MINOR VIOLATION AND GUIDELINES FOR ISSUANCE OF A NOTICE TO COMPLY"

At its April 23, 1998 public hearing, the Air Resources Board (the "Board") approved sections 60090 through 60094, Title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR), which classifies minor violations for three areas for which the ARB has primary enforcement authority: motor vehicle fuels, consumer products and cargo tank inspections (Health and Safety Code sections 43830, 41712, and 41962, respectively).

At the hearing the staff presented, and the Board approved, modifications to the regulation originally proposed in the Staff Report released on March 6, 1998, in response to comments received since the Staff Report was published. These modifications include:

- 1) modification to the language of the definition of "chronic" violation,
- 2) modification to the language regarding de minimis emissions of toxic air contaminants, and
- 3) the deletion of the regulation sunset date.

Attached is a copy of Board Resolution 98-18 approving new sections 60090 through 60094, as modified. The text of the modified regulatory language is attached to the resolution. The deletions to the originally proposed text is indicated by strikeout and the new language appears in *italic underline*.

In accordance with section 11346.8 of the Government Code, the Board directed the Executive Officer to adopt sections 60090 through 60094, Title 17, California Code of Regulations, after making them available to the public for comment for a period of at least 15 days. The Board further provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, shall make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if warranted.

Written comments on the modifications approved by the Board must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board, Air Resources Board, P.O. Box 2815, Sacramento, California 95812, no later than August 1, 1998, for consideration by the Executive Officer prior to final action. Only comments

relating to the above-described modifications to the regulation shall be considered by the Executive Officer.
