MALFUNCTION AND DIAGNOSTIC SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS AND

ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES

Pursuant to your findings in review of the above-referenced regulatory action, the Air Resources Board (ARB) hereby authorizes you to correct the rulemaking record as follows:

- 1. In the Final Regulation Order, Title 13 CCR, Section 1968.2 replace page 77 and in Title 13 CCR, Section 1968.5 replace page 26 to reflect non-substantial changes to the authority cited sections.
- 2. Behind tab 8 "Economic and Fiscal Impact Statement" add memo from the Department of Finance and substitute the attached form 399 with that which was originally submitted.
- 3. Substitute the attached "Revised Table of Contents" with that which was originally submitted, to reflect addition of memo from the Department of Finance; and
- 4. Substitute the attached revised "Certification" for closing the rulemaking record with that which was originally submitted, to reflect reopening of the rulemaking record to include addition of or changes to the above-mentioned documents.
