EXECUTIVE ORDER G-97-061

WHEREAS, on March 27, 1997, the Air Resources Board ("Board") conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed adoption of a Statewide Portable Equipment Registration Program.

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 97-16, in which the Board approved adoption of sections 2450-2465, Title 13, California Code of Regulations;

WHEREAS, Resolution 97-16 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the amendments set forth in the attachments after making them available to the public for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments regarding the changes in the regulations as originally proposed as may be submitted during this period; shall make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received; and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, the approved amendments have been made available for public comment for a period of 15 days with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44; and

WHEREAS, the written comments received during this 15-day period have been considered by the Executive Officer and do not require modification nor reconsideration by the Board of the approved regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 97-16 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that sections 2450-2465, Title 13, California Code of Regulations, and the incorporated test procedures are adopted as set forth in the attachments to Resolution 97-16.
