NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED GUIDELINES FOR A ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE INCENTIVE PROGRAM PURSUANT TO AB 2061 (LOWENTHAL)

By notice issued November 3, 2000, the Air Resources Board (ARB) announced it would conduct a public meeting to consider proposed guidelines for a zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) incentive program created by Assembly Bill (AB) 2061 (Lowenthal). AB 2061 provides grants of up to \$3,000, for three 12-month periods, to qualified recipients to encourage the purchase or lease of a new ZEV between October 1, 2000, and December 31, 2000. The meeting was scheduled for November 16, 2000, at the Air Resources Board's hearing room, lower level, 2020 L Street, Sacramento California.
