EXECUTIVE ORDER D-221-14
Relating to Exemptions Under Section 27156
of the Vehicle Code

AUTOMOTIVE CONTROLS CORPORATION
ACCEL 45 SERIES DUAL POINT DISTRIBUTOR
PART NUMBERS 45100A, 45101A, 45102A, 45103A, 45107A,
45200A, 45201A, 45202A, 45204A, 45300A, 45301A and 45302A

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Section 27156 of the Vehicle Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39515 and Section 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-5;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the installation of the ACCEL 45 Series Dual Point Distributor (mechanical advance only), manufactured by Automotive Controls Corporation, 175 North Branford Rd., Branford, CT 06405, has been found not to reduce the effectiveness of required motor vehicle pollution control devices and, therefore, is exempt from the prohibitions of Section 27156 of the Vehicle Code for the following vehicle applications:

45100A	1955-1980 General Motors vehicles equipped with Chevrolet 8 cylinder engines.
45101A	1966-1979 AMC vehicles equipped with 290, 304, 360 and 401 CID engines.
45102A	1960-1980 General Motors vehicles equipped with Pontiac 326, 350, 389, 400, 421 and 455 CID engines.
45103A	1965-1980 General Motors vehicles equipped with Oldsmobile 330, 350, 400, 403, 425 and 455 CID engines.
45107A	1965-1980 General Motors vehicles equipped with "tall deck" 366, 427 and 454 CID engines.
45200A	1958-1970 Ford Motor Company vehicles equipped with 352, 390, 406, 427 and 428 CID engines.

THIS EXECUTIVE ORDER DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A CERTIFICATION, ACCREDITATION, APPROVAL, OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF ENDORSEMENT BY THE AIR RESOURCES BOARD OF ANY CLAIMS OF THE APPLICANT CONCERNING ANTI-POLLUTION BENEFITS OR ANY ALLEGED BENEFITS OF AUTOMOTIVE CONTROLS CORPORATION'S ACCEL 45 Dual Point DISTRIBUTOR (MECHANICAL ADVANCE ONLY), PART NUMBERS 45100A, 45101A, 45102A, 45103A, 45107A, 45200A, 45201A, 45202A, 45204A, 45300A, 45301A AND 45302A.

No claims of any kind, such as "Approved by the Air Resources Board" may be made with respect to the action taken herein in any advertising or other oral or written communication.


Section 17500 of the Business and Professions Code makes untrue or misleading advertising unlawful, and Section 17534 makes violation punishable as a misdemeanor.

Section 43644 of the Health and Safety Code provides as follows:

"43644, (a) No person shall install, sell, offer for sale, or advertise, or, except in an application to the state board for certification of a device, represent, any device as a motor vehicle pollution control device for use on any used motor vehicle unless that device has been certified by the state board. No person shall sell, offer for sale, advertise, or represent any motor vehicle pollution control device as a certified device which, in fact, is not a certified device. Any violations of this subdivision is a misdemeanor."

Any apparent violation of the conditions of this Executive Order will be submitted to the Attorney General of California for such action as he deems advisable.
