Dear Mr. Corey:

Thank you for your letter dated June 5, 2013 regarding the Program and Fiscal Review of the Lake County Air Quality Management District's (District) Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program) for Fiscal Years 2006-2007, 2007-2008, and 2009-2010 conducted by California Air Resources Board (CARB) staff. The District appreciates the Report's positive assessment of our Carl Moyer Program resulting in no "Findings" and one "Recommendation". In response to your Recommendation that "the District request case-by-case determinations for circumstances that deviate from or are not covered by the Guidelines" we offer the following:

District staff submits all Carl Moyer Program projects to CARB staff for case-by-case determinations and approval prior to entering into a contract with the applicant. The District has been in the practice of submitting all projects to CARB due to the uniqueness of our Carl Moyer Program. We have considered your recommendation and will continue with our policy to receive CARB determination for each project. The District may consider sending the request for determination in a more formal manner to CARB for each project. We trust CARB staff will follow through by sending a formal response to the District of the determination made.

We here at the LCAQMD are proud of our clean air program achievements, the latest of which being ranked # 1 IN THE NATION according to the 2012 American Lung Association State of the Air Report. Additionally, the District has met all of California and State Ambient Air Quality Standards for the past 23 consecutive years.

We appreciate your staff's professionalism and cooperation to engage in a productive and interactive dialogue. We look forward to continued success in the implementation of the District's Carl Moyer Program.
