The Air Resources Board (ARB) has concluded a program and fiscal review of the Lake County Air Quality Management District's (District) Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program). The scope of these reviews includes grants made in fiscal years 2006-07, 2007-08, and 2009-10.

During the period of time covered by this review, the District administered approximately \$370,000 in State grants. The District replaced 8 engines with these Carl Moyer Program funds.

ARB's program review report is enclosed. Our review confirms that the District has achieved early and surplus emission reductions through its Carl Moyer Program projects, and has met the State's overall expenditure requirements for the program. ARB staff has identified no findings and offers one recommendation for the District's Carl Moyer Program.

Under established program review guidelines, the District has 30 days from the date of this cover letter to submit comments, if desired, on the enclosed report. The report and any District comments will then be posted together on ARB's website. We also encourage you to make this information available to residents within the District.


