Dear Authorized Installer:

Recently, the California Air Resources Board mailed more than 70,000 letters to a targeted group of diesel vehicle owners that may be required to take action to comply with the Statewide Truck and Bus regulation, title 13, California Code of Regulations, section 2025. While exempt from the regulation, the mailing list failed to exclude personal use motorhome owners. Unfortunately, this caused some confusion regarding compliance requirements.

We have received several calls from concerned motorhome owners inquiring if they need to comply with the cleanup requirements. As you know, section 2025(c)(10) defines motorhomes used strictly for personal use as being exempt from the regulation. As such, if any motorhome owner seeks information about having a retrofit particulate matter filter installed on their personal use motorhome, you need to make sure your authorized dealers and installers inform the customer that the retrofit is not required and do not install it.
