IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Blue Bird Body Company 1973 model-year heavy-duty diesel engine powered vehicles are approved as described below:

Section 39152, Part 1, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that a decal be affixed to the side window which discloses the highest emissions from the certification fleet for that vehicle for which approval has been granted by the Board.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

<u>Engine Manufacturer</u>	<u>California Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbons Plus Nitrogen Dioxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>
Cummins	211	12.2	8.6

These values are effective until the termination of 1973 model-year production.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, the California Highway Patrol, and the Bureau of Automotive Repair of the Department of Consumer Affairs will be notified of this approval by copy of this order.
