Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Di Giorgio Leisure Products gasoline-powered 1973 model-year heavy-duty motor vehicles (Motor Homes) are approved for the models described below:
