EXECUTIVE ORDER A-53  
Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

FMC CORPORATION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That FMC Corporation gasoline-powered 1973 model year heavy-duty motor vehicles (motor homes) are approved for the models described below:

<u>Vehicle Model</u>	<u>Engine Manufacturer</u>	<u>California Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size</u>	<u>Engine Approval Executive Order No.</u>
FMC 2900R	Chrysler Corp.	R.B.M.	440	A-9-2

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbons Plus Nitrogen Dioxide gms/BHP-hr</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide gms/BHP-hr</u>
RBM	14	12
