Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

LAZY DAZE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Lazy Daze gasoline-powered 1973 model-year heavy-duty motor vehicles (motorhomes) are approved for the models described below:

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.
