EXECUTIVE ORDER A-341-2
Relating to Certification of New Heavy-Duty Engines and Vehicles

GENERAL ENGINE PRODUCTS

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board at Sections 43100, 43101, and 43102 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned at Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-9;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following engines and exhaust emission control systems produced by the manufacturer are certified for use in motor vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) over 14,000 pounds:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed engine models comply with the "California Motor Vehicle Emission Control and Smog Index Label Specifications" (Title 13, California Code of Regulations, Section 1965).

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
