EXECUTIVE ORDER A-10-73-1
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

FORD MOTOR COMPANY

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43103 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Ford Motor Company exhaust emission control systems for 1977 model-year passenger cars are certified for the engine family described below:

Engine Family: 2.8 "BV" (1CV1)

Engine: 171 CID

Transmission: 3 speed automatic

Exhaust Emission Control Systems: Air injection, exhaust gas recirculation, oxidation catalyst

Model: Mustang II 2 Door Sedan
Mustang II Ghia 2 Door Sedan
Mustang II (2+2) 3 Door Sedan
Mustang II Mach I 3 Door Sedan
Cobra II 3 Door Sedan

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this certification is contingent upon Ford Motor Company affixing a permanent catalyst overheat warning label on the driver's sun-visor of all catalyst-equipped vehicles. This label must be approved by the Executive Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That this certification is also contingent upon Ford Motor Company listing in the owner's manual the operating cautions associated with a catalyst-equipped vehicle. This listing must be approved by the Executive Officer.

These vehicles are in addition to those previously certified for this engine family.

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, the California Highway Patrol, and the Bureau of Automotive Repair will be notified by copy of this order and attachment.
