**PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF A PROPOSED  
REGULATION FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF HIGH GLOBAL WARMING  
POTENTIAL REFRIGERANTS FOR STATIONARY SOURCES**

Staff's Suggested Modifications to the Original Proposal

PRESENTED AT THE DECEMBER 9 -10, 2009 HEARING  
OF THE AIR RESOURCES BOARD

This document contains staff's suggested modifications to the proposed Regulation for the Management of High Global Warming Potential Refrigerants for Stationary Sources, which is contained in Appendix A to the Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on October 23, 2009. Modified regulatory language has not yet been developed for these suggested modifications; staff intends to work with the regulated community to develop this language.

The text of all proposed modifications will be made available to the public for a fifteen-day comment period. Following is a brief description of the suggested modifications.

Exempt Military Tactical Support Equipment

ARB staff has received comments from Edwards Air Force Base and the Department of Defense regional office requesting an exemption under the proposed regulation for their tactical support equipment. ARB staff has considered this request and believes that the proposed regulation should be modified to exempt tactical support equipment due to its specific use in military applications. Staff proposes to work with Edwards Air Force Base and other interested parties to develop the proposed changes.

Clarifying Language

In response to comments received from the stakeholders regarding the need for clarification of some provisions of the regulation, staff plans to make clarifying changes and make the modified regulatory language available for public comment.
