Executive Order R-09-008

Relating to Adoption of a Regulation to Reduce Sulfur Hexafluoride Emissions in
Non-Semiconductor and Non-Utility Applications

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2009, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed adoption of a Regulation to Reduce Sulfur Hexafluoride Emissions in Non-Semiconductor and Non-Utility Applications of sections 95340, 95341, 95342, 95343, 95344, 95345, and 95346, title 17, California Code of Regulations;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 09-23, in which the Board approved sections 95340, 95341, 95342, 95343, 95344, 95345, and 95346, title 17, California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachment A thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-23, directed the Executive Officer to take final action to adopt the regulatory amendments set forth in Attachment A, and such other conforming modifications as may be appropriate, after making the modified regulatory language available for public comment for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, shall make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if the Executive Officer determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2009, the approved regulations, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, have been made available for public comment for a period of 15 days in accordance with the provisions of title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44; and

WHEREAS, the written comments received during this 15 day period have been considered by the Executive Officer and do not require modification or reconsideration by the Board of the approved regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 09-23 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that sections 95340, 95341, 95342, 95343, 95344, 95345, and 95346, title 17, California Code of Regulations, are approved and adopted as set forth in Attachment I to this Order.
