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The Office of Administrative Law (OAL) is authorized to make the following corrections, substitutions, and additions in connection with the above-referenced rulemaking:

- (1) Substitute the enclosed revised final regulation text (seven copies provided) behind each copy of the Form 400 for filing with the Secretary of State.
- (2) Remove the Document Incorporated by Reference SAE J2727 AUG 2008, from the rulemaking file. This document was inadvertently included in the file but should be removed because it is not incorporated in this rulemaking.

For further clarification, the incorporated document listed in the public hearing notice, "California Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for 2001 and Subsequent Model Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks, and Medium-Duty Vehicles" (last amended September 27, 2010)" was recently amended during this rulemaking. During the fifteen day notice period, ARB added the revised updated emission standard and test procedure which is now titled "California 2001 Through 2014 Model Criteria Pollutant Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures and 2009 Through 2016 Model Greenhouse Gas Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks, and Medium-Duty Vehicles," as last amended March 22, 2012, and also added the "California 2015 and Subsequent Model Criteria Pollutant Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures and 2017 and Subsequent Model Greenhouse Gas Exhaust Emission Standards and Test Procedures for Passenger Cars, Light-Duty Trucks, and Medium-Duty Vehicles," which was adopted March 22, 2012.
