State of California AIR RESOURCES BOARD

Executive Order 98-008

WHEREAS, on December 11, 1997, the Air Resources Board (the Board or ARB) conducted a hearing to consider regulatory amendments to the California Heavy-Duty Vehicle Inspection Program (HDVIP) and Periodic Smoke Inspection Program (PSIP);

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on December 11, 1997, the Board adopted Resolution 97-44, in which the Board approved the regulatory amendments set forth in Attachment A thereto, with the modifications identified in Attachment B thereto;

WHEREAS, Attachment A to Resolution 97-44 contained amendments to sections 2180 through 2194, title 13, California Code of Regulations, as originally proposed by staff;

WHEREAS, Resolution 97-44 directed the Executive Officer to incorporate into the approved amendments the modifications described in Attachment B thereto, with such other conforming modifications as may be appropriate, to make the modified regulatory language available to the public for a supplemental 15-day comment period, and thereafter either to adopt the approved amendments with such additional modifications as may be appropriate in light of supplemental comments received, or to present the amendments to the Board for further consideration if warranted in light of supplemental written comments received;

WHEREAS, the Board-approved modifications to the originally proposed text were made available for a supplemental 15-day comment period, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44, with the modifications clearly indicated;

WHEREAS, one written comment was received during the supplemental 15-day comment period, and that comment has been considered by the Executive Officer; and

WHEREAS, Attachment 1 hereto contains the text of the amendments to sections 2180 through 2194, title 13, California Code of Regulations, with the modifications made available for the 15-day supplemental comment period incorporated.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 97-44 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with Resolution 97-44 and Health and Safety Code sections 39515 and 39516, that the amendments to sections sections 2180 through 2194, title 13, California Code of Regulations, are hereby adopted as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.
