## PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF NEW EMISSION STANDARDS, FLEET REQUIREMENTS, AND TEST PROCEDURES FOR FORKLIFTS AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL EQUIPMENT

In the notice of public availability of modified text dated December 1, 2006, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) inadvertently omitted the hydrocarbons plus oxides of nitrogen (HC+NOx) and carbon monoxide (CO) standards for severe-duty engines from section 1048.101(a)(2) of the California Exhaust and Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for New 2007 through 2009 Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engines. The standards were included in the California Exhaust and Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for New 2010 and Later Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engines. Our intention was that the standards for severe-duty engines appear in both documents. Note 1 is also added as it applies in the 2007-2009 model years.

The first erratum corrects the text following the Exhaust Emission Standards table in section 1048.101(a)(2) of the California Exhaust and Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for New 2007 through 2009 Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engines by inserting the sentence "For severe-duty engines, the HC+NOx standard is 0.8 grams per kilowatt hour (g/kW-hr) and the CO standard is 130.0 g/kW-hr" prior to the sentence "The following engines are not subject to the transient standards in this paragraph (a):"

The second erratum inserts the following note just below the Exhaust Emission Standards table in section 1048.101(a)(2) of the California Exhaust and Evaporative Emission Standards and Test Procedures for New 2007 through 2009 Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engines: "Note: (1) Standards in grams per kilowatt-hour are given only as a reference. Pollutant emissions reported to ARB by manufacturers must be in grams per brake horsepower-hour."

The attached document highlights the errata corrections in section 1048.101(a)(2) by displaying the new text in italics and double underline font.
