State of California AIR RESOURCES BOARD

Executive Order G-99-074

WHEREAS, on December 11, 1998, the Air Resources Board (Board) conducted a public hearing to consider amendments to the specifications for liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) intended for use in motor vehicles, including a permanent 10 volume percent maximum propene limit, along with the limits for butanes, butenes, pentanes and heavier;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 98-80, in which the Board approved the amendments to section 2296.6, title 13, California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachment A thereto, with the modifications identified in Attachment B thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 98-80 directed the Executive Officer to incorporate into the approved amendments the modifications approved therein and such other conforming modifications as may be appropriate, and either to adopt the modified regulations and amendments, after making them available to the public for a supplemental written comment period of 15 days, with such additional modifications as may be appropriate in light of supplemental comments received, or to present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if the Executive Officer determines that this is warranted in light of supplemental written comments received;

WHEREAS, the approved amendments to regulations were made available by a Notice of Availability of Modified Text for a supplemental 15-day comment period in accordance with the provisions of section 44, title 1, California Code of Regulations, with the modifications clearly indicated;

WHEREAS, in light of written comments were received during the supplemental 15-day comment period, additional modifications to the proposed amendments were made available by a Second Notice of Availability of Modified Text for a second supplemental 15-day comment period in accordance with the provisions of section 44, title 1, California Code of Regulations, with the additional modifications clearly indicated;

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has considered the written comments made in response to the Second Notice of Availability of Modified Text and has determined that no additional modifications are necessary or appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Attachment 1 hereto contains the modified amendments to section 2296.6, title 13, California Code of Regulations, that were made available with the Second Notice of Availability of Modified Text.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 98-80 are incorporated by reference herein.
