SUBJECT: Portable Equipment Registration Program Regulations

The Air Resources Board would bring to your attention a change in §2453(j) of the referenced regulations. Section 2453(j) allows owners of non-operational equipment to apply for registration. The regulation was drafted with the assumption that owners would have approximately 90 days in which to do that, and accordingly a date of July 1, 2005 was included in the regulation. With the delay in implementation, that date is no longer feasible. ARB has elected to have OAL insert the effective date of the regulation at various points in the regulation. ARB has revised §2453(j) by removing the July 1, 2005 date and replacing it with 90 days from the effective date. This modification does not materially alter any requirement in the regulation, but simply effects the ongoing intent to provide these operators with a window of opportunity to register any non-operational equipment.
