The California Air Resources Board (ARB) staff is holding a public workshop to discuss a draft regulatory proposal for amendments to the Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) program for Gasoline Dispensing Facilities (GDF).

This Workshop is a follow-up to the March 2 Workshop where ARB staff presented several regulatory concepts intended to clarify certain EVR provisions; minimize inconvenience for GDF operators, and fully realize the emissions benefits envisioned for the EVR program. Based on feedback from industry and the regulated community, ARB staff has refined the concepts presented at the March 2 Workshop covering the following topics:

- Clarification of the Four-Year Clock when Implementing New EVR Standards and Specifications at Existing GDFs.
- Suspension of ISD Pressure Alarms during Winter Months.
- Spillage, Spitting, and Post-Fueling Standards for Conventional Nozzles at Onboard Refueling Vapor Recovery Fleet GDFs.
- Low Permeation Hose Standards.
- Minor Administrative and Editorial Changes to Certification Procedures, Test Procedures, and Definitions.

This workshop will include a presentation by staff on the proposed regulation, followed by a question and answer period. Copies of the draft regulatory language and supporting documents, and a Workshop agenda will be posted on the 2010 EVR Rulemaking web
